REGISTRATION

Registration is now open! Afterschool programming can and will fill up, and we recommend you sign up as soon as possible! There is a one-time \$35 registration fee which is due when you register. For all of our Afterschool programs, registration and weekly fees are due the Wednesday before the week your child attends; this allows us to ensure proper staffing, supplies, snacks, and an age-appropriate schedule for those in attendance. YOU'RE IN GOOD HANDS

Staff, as role models, are selected for sound judgment, maturity, experience, enthusiasm, and creativity. All staff are interviewed and go through a complete background check prior to being hired. Training occurs before the school year and throughout the program to ensure attention to detail. All staff are certified in CPR & First Aid.

Our programs focus on encouraging character growth through care, honesty, respect, responsibility, and faith. You can be sure that our Y staff is committed to developing these traits through our Back to School program activities, and that all activity areas are well supervised.

Our average Elementary Afterschool staff to student ratio is 1:12 and 1:15 for our Middle School Afterschool program. By selecting our Back to School programming, you are investing in a safe, fun, educational, and memorable experience for your child.



DAILY LOGISTICS

Our Elementary Afterschool Program and Middle School Afterschool Program operates every day that your child's school is in session. At the end of the school day, depending on the school, students either remain at their school for Afterschool under the care of Y staff or a Y bus transports them to their appropriate Afterschool location.

The programs operate from the end of the school day until 6:00 P.M. All students must be picked up by 6:00 P.M. by their guardian(s) or any additional person listed on their pick-up form. Students who are picked up late will be charged \$1 for every minute that they are late.

Child care for teacher workdays, holidays, intercession, and camps will be held at the Brunswick County Afterschool locations, Hampstead United Methodist Church, Midtown YMCA, Nir Family YMCA, Sampson County YMCA. Students may be dropped off from 7am to 9am and picked up from 4pm to 6pm. Teacher workdays, holidays, intercession, and camps are an additional cost to the program. Please be sure to pack a swim suit, towel, and lunch on each of these days; an email will go out to all registered parents before the week begins outlining the field trips and all other pertinent details for these days.

AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS

Continuing into the 2026-2027 school year, we are holding site-based afterschool clubs! In addition to our regular activities, students can choose from a variety of quarterly clubs, such as:

- Sports: Basketball Basics, Soccer Skills, Track & Field Fun, Yoga for Kids, Dance
- Arts: Acrylic Painting, Clay Art, Photography, Theater Workshops
- Reading: Book Club, Storytelling Circle, Comic Book Creations
- Math: Math Games, Puzzle Challenges, Lego Building, Sudoku
- Writing: Creative Writing, Journalism, Card Writing for Causes
- Community Service: Environmental Club, Volunteer Club

Club days and offerings will vary by location each quarter.

YMCA ELEMENTARY AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM

Serving students in grades K-5

The Y Afterschool Program offers a safe, engaging environment where children can grow socially, physically, and academically. With a focus on health, character development, and well-being, our program provides activities like sports, swimming (at Nir Family YMCA), outdoor play, STEM projects, and more. Children receive a healthy snack, at least 30 minutes of structured homework help, and 30 minutes of physical activity daily. The program follows Healthy Eating and Physical Activity (HEPA) standards to promote a balanced lifestyle.

Rooted in the Y's core values of caring, honesty, respect, responsibility, and faith, the program encourages self-expression and exploration. Continuing in the 2026-2027 school year, we will also offer site-based afterschool clubs to further support children's interests. Afterschool care is available every school day from dismissal until 6:00 pm, with transportation to designated Y locations when needed.

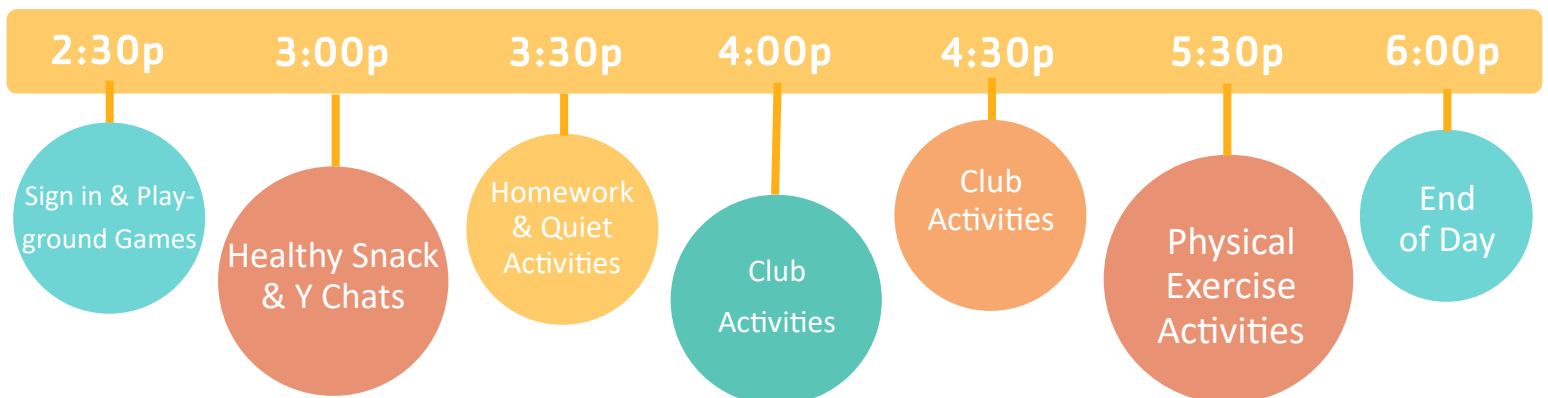

Serving students in grades 6-8

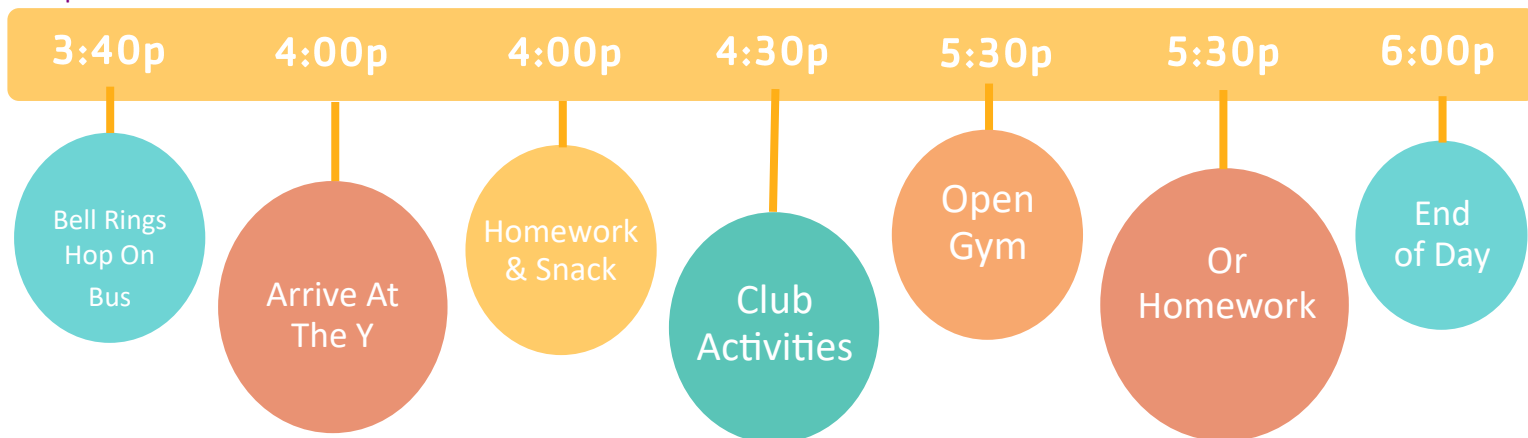
The YMCA's Middle School Afterschool program is for students in grades 6-8 attending our Midtown YMCA, Nir Family YMCA and Town Creek Middle School. We provide a variety of programmatic and activity options to enhance your child's confidence, enrich his or her social and physical development, explore and develop interests and talents, and encourage self-expression. Students will receive a daily snack, complete homework, participate in club activities such as soccer, Esports, reading, flag football, and more as well as have the opportunity to learn from our partners on topics such as mental health, career readiness, college, banking, and more. Pickup is by 6pm.

TEACHER WORKDAY, HOLIDAYS, & INTERCESSION

When school is out, the Y is in! During Intercession breaks, Christmas break, Spring break, Teacher Workdays, and Holidays, children have the opportunity to come to the Y for a full day of activities where children will learn new sports and games, create arts and crafts, develop good sportsmanship, be a part of a team, build new friendships, swim, learn to be healthy, and much more! YMCA locations and dates are determined by the school calendar and schools we serve. Please be extra cognizant as you sign up for these days and make note of which location you are registering your child to attend.



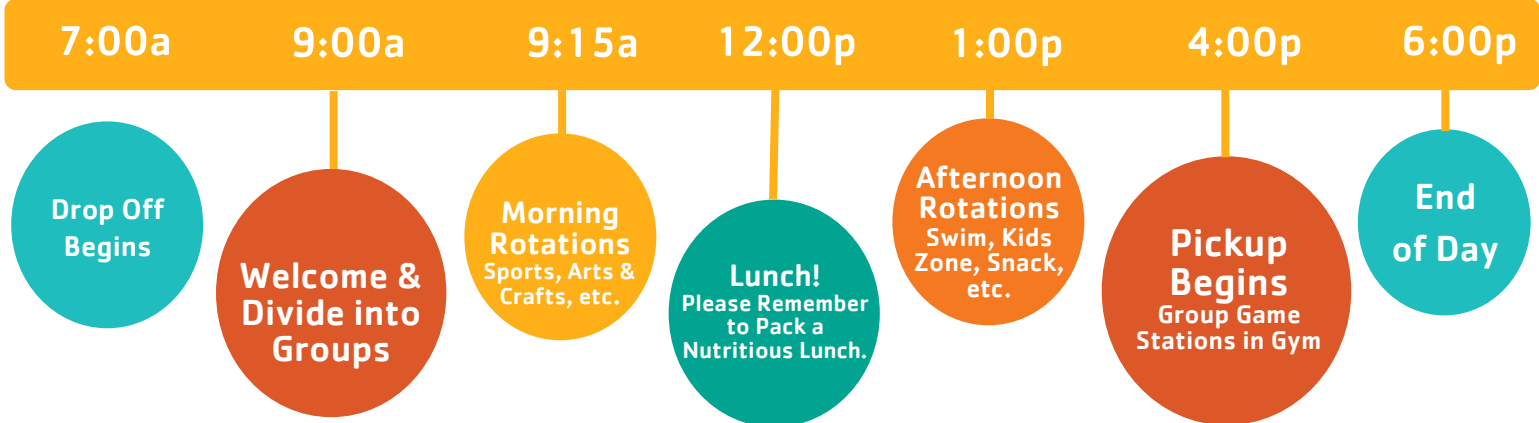
During each full week, we will take at least two field trips that will engage the mind and body and give students the opportunity to explore their local community and engage in activities outside of the Y such as Camp Kirkwood, Aquarium at Fort Fisher, Flip N Fly, and more. Single teacher workdays and holidays will mainly be held at Brunswick County Afterschool locations, Hampstead United Methodist Church, Midtown YMCA, Nir Family YMCA, and the Sampson County YMCA, but may include a trip to the local park. Your child will be active, have fun, and will want to keep coming back day after day.

Registration is separate from Afterschool, locations can fill to capacity, and we encourage you to register today for all dates you need; please register no later than five business days in advance so that we can ensure proper staffing, supplies, food, and a fun-filled schedule.
